## MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

The medium of instruction will be Hindi/English. Examination may be written in Hindi or English except in language subject.

## ATTENDANCE

Students are expected to attend the class and other activity regularly. A student must have completed 75% attendance, otherwise he/she will not be permitted in the B.Ed. final examination. Under unavoidable circumstances prior permission for leaves is essential. Leave application should be addressed to the Principal only. The application must be recommended by the concerned teacher of the Department.

## IDENTY CARD

All student to B. Ed. Course of this college will get identity card on prescribed fee of Rs. 100/- which shall remain valid till completion of the Course.

## DRESS CODE

All the student of B.Ed. regular programme will have to attend their class in the uniform prescribed by the college. For boys Black pant ,white full shirt, black tie, black shoes with black shocks and for girls Pink Saree, Pink Blause white shoes with white shocks. In winter Pink blazer in common for both. The core subject is suitably supported by theoretical aspects as well as practical concerns of teaching. Suggested syllabus may be modified whenever required in the light of the syllabus prescribed by NCTE and followed by University.





## ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Students seeking admission to the B.Ed college have to apply on the College admission form prescribed for the purpose which is available at Sidhnath B.Ed College Counter.

Admission shall be made on merit basis i.e. marks obtained in their academic exam as per the guide line and norms of Nilamber-Pitamber University.

3. College Leaving Certificate (Original)
4. Migration certificate accept N.P.U.(Original)
5. Residential/Domicile certificate.
6. Attested copy of the caste certificate ,issued by the competent authority (DM/DC/SDO) or any other authorised officer in respect of SC/ST/BC/OBC candidates ,seeking admission on reserved quota

Attach three copies of colour photograph ( write your name, application form no. and course applied on the back), excluding one photography pasted on the application form and two on the admit cards

Please attach the 2<sup>nd</sup> copy of money receipt with the admission form, otherwise form will not be entertained

### NOTE

- Application should be presented by the candidate in the office personally.
- All original certificates should be brought for verification on the day counseling.
- Documents(Xerox) should be attested by competent authority while producing.

## How to apply for Admission

- (1) Interested candidates can apply for the admission by getting form available at college office by paying Rs. 700/- (General/OBC) and Rs. 500/- (ST/SC/PH) in Cash or DD in favour of Sidhnath B.Ed .College payable at SBI Hussainabad Palamu.

## DURATION OF COURSE

- The course duration is of two academic year starting from July each year.
- The final examination leading to the award of the degree shall be held at the end of the academic session on the date notified by the Nilamber-Pitamber University.

There shall be at least 200 working days in a year excluding the period of admission, examination etc... Besides, every trainee shall be required to undergo internship in teaching (including practice teaching and skill development) for at least 4 weeks in 1st year and 16 weeks in second years in nearby secondary/ senior secondary schools allotted by the Head of the institution.

## INTAKE

For one academic session 2 units i.e. 100 student will be admitted in B.Ed. Regular course based on the marks obtained on various related academic examination and following the norms of reservation of Jharkhand state.

## ELIGIBILITY EXCEPTIONS

Candidates with at least 50% marks either in the bachelor's Degree and/or in the Master's Degree in Science/Social Sciences/Humanity, Bachelor's in Engineering and Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the programme.

## RESERVATION

The reservation and relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Government / State Government, whichever is applicable.
